*R-value varies based on the profile of the siding it is paired with. The more insulation that fits behind the siding, the higher the r-value. R-value means the resistance to heat flow. The higher the r-value, the greater the insulating power. Tiny air pockets in the insulation resist the transfer of heat. The thicker the insulation, the more air pockets, and higher the R-value.
